

Tuition & Expenses

Estimated Costs

International students are required by U.S. Immigration to be full-time students during the fall and spring semesters. Registering for less than full-time must be authorized by an International Student Advisor (ISA). If you are a study abroad student, your home institution may have additional requirements.

Tuition due date: Generally, tuition is paid at the beginning of each semester. Students may pay tuition before they arrive at HPU (see tuition payment options) or upon their arrival.
